WHO? The contest is open to all BCPS students.

HOW?

- The poster must: include the theme, reflect Baltimore, be designed in portrait/vertical orientation, and be at least 11 inches wide and 18 inches tall.
- Each student may submit one poster.
- All entries will become the property of the BCPS Office of Educational Options and will not be returned.
- Each entry must include the student's full name, teacher's full name, school, and grade level.

PRIZES

- Student and teacher recognition during current school year, and at the 2019 National Conference on Magnet Schools
- \$500 in classroom supplies to teacher of winning student
- Winning poster featured at the 2019 National Conference on Magnet Schools

SCORING

Posters will be scored on four criteria: (1) use of the theme, (2) use of color and design, (3) originality, and (4) unique expression reflecting Baltimore.
