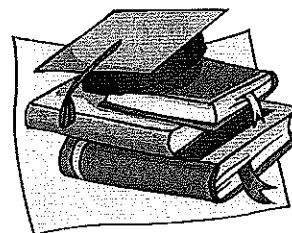

AdvancePath Academy

AdvancePath Academy uses computer-adaptive curriculum and small group, teacher led-instruction. *Description of self-paced program:

A teacher-directed, individualized, self-paced program for highly-motivated students. The teacher serves as a resource and an evaluator who directs and coaches the student. Group discussions and seminars are scheduled in which students actively participate. A course may be taken for original credit. Students may take only one course at a time.

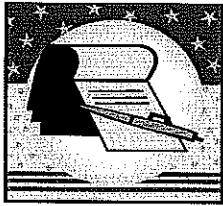
Student Responsibilities:

1. Attend every class.
2. Complete all assignments while working with the teacher.
3. Fully and correctly complete the packet.
4. Work independently at home and/or in public library.

Student Qualifications:

1. Unable to take the specific class in day or evening school.
2. Highly motivated.
3. Successful at completing assignments independently.

Students must register by February 25, 2012.

Entrance Requirements, Registration, and Fees

Evening/Saturday High Schools are open to any high school student.

To register, a student must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

A day school concurrently enrolled student must obtain a completed admission form from the day school and bring it with the course fee to register. When applicable, tuition waiver and a copy of medical assistance card are also required.

- ◆ A reassigned student must obtain from the superintendent's designee: a completed admission form.
- ◆ Students not enrolled in a Baltimore County public school must bring a letter from their day schools, their student SR1 record card(s), immunization record(s), five (5) documents to prove residency, and course fees.
- ◆ Students ages 16-21 who have dropped out of school and non-BCPS students must bring copies of their IEP snapshots and IEP team notes, if applicable, and most recent quarterly report cards to registration.
- ◆ Concurrently enrolled Baltimore County day school student: \$100 per credit, \$50 per half credit.
- ◆ Nonresident/non-BCPS student: \$250 per credit, \$125 per half credit.

All fees are due at registration. (checks, money orders, or MasterCard/VISA accepted) - NO CASH.

Refunds must be requested before the second class session. Textbooks are loaned to all students. All books must be returned at the end of each course or when students withdraw. Students are expected to provide their own paper, notebooks, pens, and transportation. Checks for non-sufficient funds will be reported to the Maryland State's Attorney's Office, if collection fails.

Attendance Policy and Rules

Students must attend each class unless there is personal illness, death in the family, or court-related matters. Students with poor attendance within each grading period are subject to a failing classwork grade. Students whose attendance is irregular will be withdrawn and will not receive a passing grade, if appropriate counseling does not improve their attendance.

Expectations and Course Information

All policies and rules of Baltimore County Public Schools are enforced in Evening/Saturday High Schools. All sites enforce rules as per the school system's *Student Handbook*. All students receive and must sign acknowledgment of receipt forms after reviewing the expectations at the time of registration. Course requirements are the same as day school. Two credits may be earned each year in one evening high school. By attending two evening schools, it is possible to earn four credits per year. Additional credit(s) may be earned in Saturday High School.

A graduation ceremony and reception are held annually.

Grading Periods End: March 30 and June 14

Inclement Weather Policy: When schools are closed or close early, evening high school is canceled.

Loch Raven Saturday School will be closed if all BCPS weekend activities are canceled or the snow emergency plan is in effect.

If schools are closed seven days due to emergency conditions, it will be necessary to alter the school calendar. Additional days may be scheduled as required at the end of the school year. Depending on the use of emergency closing time, the calendar may be reduced if the time is not needed to meet the minimum required days/hours.
