

FISHING TO LEARN GAME – LANGUAGE ARTS

This game creates a fun way to learn, and it is inexpensive and easy to make. It is great to play at home with your child while helping to reinforce sight and/or spelling words.

Materials Needed:

- 1 basket or bowl
- 1 small stick or pole
- 1 box of paper clips
- 1 magnetic clip (can be purchased at a dollar store)
- 1 list of sight and/or spelling words
- 1 bright-colored used box

Number of Players: Can be played alone or with others.

Preparation:

1. Cut fish shapes from the box and write sight and/or spelling words on the blank side of the fish. Slip on paper clip.
2. Fill bowl or basket with the cardboard fish.
3. Place the magnet side up.
4. Tie a string to the stick or small pole.
5. Attach magnetic clip to the other end of the string.

How to Play:

1. Have your child hold the fishing pole over the bowl or basket, placing the magnetic clip on the cardboard fish.
2. Have your child identify the word he has fished out of the bowl.
