Check the questions you may want to ask during your next parent/teacher conference.

- What strengths does my child bring to this class?
- What are some of my child's needs?
- Is my child being sufficiently challenged academically?
- How do you vary instruction for students who are more advanced in your content area?
- What kinds of opportunities and choices do students have to enrich and extend their learning in your class?
- What can I do at home to help my child?
- What are your expectations regarding homework?
- What type of homework assignments will my child receive?
- What are the graduation requirements, and is my child on schedule for completing all requirements?
- What is the grading policy? What percentage of the grade is based on tests?
- How are students being prepared for the Maryland School Assessments and for the High School Assessments?
- Are there projects, reports, or presentations? If so, how do they affect the grade?
- Is tutoring or extra help available?
- What are your attendance guidelines, and what provisions are in place for my child to make up work that is missed?
- Are there any special programs that could be considered for my child?
- What accommodations are necessary for my child, and how are they being provided throughout the school environment?
- Are there any activities that could help my child prepare for next year or level?
