  - During the hours that tutors are not available, students can submit questions through **24/7 Help** and will receive a response within 24 hours.
  - Choose **Homework Help**, if you need help with your homework.  
Choose **Skills Building**, if you need help learning a specific skill or subject, such as mastering long division or improving your reading comprehension, beginning or organizing an essay/research paper.

## BALITMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

### ❖ **Towson University Reading Clinic 410-704-2558**

- The clinic provides individual assessment and academic tutoring for ages 5 to adult. Students work individually with master's degree candidates. A small fee is required. Scholarships are available.

### ❖ **Remedial Education and Counseling Help Program (REACH) 410-467-9247**

- This program is a nonprofit organization offering remedial tutoring, enrichment, SAT preparation, and diagnostic testing.

### ❖ **Dyslexia Tutoring Program 410-889-5487**

- This program teaches reading to low-income children and adults who are dyslexic or have a language-based learning difference. This is accomplished through professional assessment and tutoring by volunteers who are trained in the Orton-Gillingham Method of Reading, Writing, and Spelling.
