Art & Science

Students participate in authentic learning activities in both the fine arts and science to enrich their daily classroom experiences from kindergarten through Grade 5. Hands-on, cooperative learning is emphasized, and state-of-the-art technology is used to enhance instruction. In the arts magnet, students use graphic software along with examples of professional artwork to produce work that strengthens students' reading and language skills. In the science magnet, students expand their knowledge of the scientific method through hands-on investigations as well as a variety of science-based programs and assemblies that reinforce the Scientific Method and result in individual projects. Students complete all curricular requirements of the Baltimore County Public Schools.
