

Elementary School Programs

Multi-Age Grouping

Students work in flexible instructional groups for a portion of each day. Home base classes are structured heterogeneously, including diverse abilities and ages. Grouping in this way allows students to participate in multi-age projects and integrated curricular activities. Older and younger students work together, enhancing the academic abilities and the socialization skills of both. Younger students benefit from working with experienced older students. Older students are able to take on roles involving leadership and increased responsibility. Small subgroups of students who benefit from the same type of instruction also meet at certain times of the day. Students complete all curricular requirements of the Baltimore County Public Schools.
