Science, Mathematics, and Communication

Students utilize 21st century skills and experience authentic learning in the areas of science, mathematics, and communications through daily instruction and school-wide projects. Students communicate and collaborate with each other and the local scientific community through field experiences, engineering challenges and an intermediate science fair. Web 2.0 tools are incorporated in all areas of learning, including “digital book clubs,” production of morning announcements in an in-house television studio, and creation of multi-media slide shows and videos. Students also utilize interactive Web sites to investigate math concepts and develop their mathematical literacy. Students complete all curricular requirements of the Baltimore County Public Schools.
