### Mass Communications

Students who enjoy public speaking, writing, and working with technology should investigate magnet programs in Mass Communication. The program includes opportunities to work in :

Graphic Arts includes Desktop Publishing, Photography, Graphic Design, and Yearbook. Students work together to produce a variety of television programs, including daily news broadcasts, photo-journals, and the yearbook.

Communications Technology includes television and radio broadcasting, video production, public speaking, and journalism. Both pathways include internship opportunities for seniors as well as parallel college enrollment.

Students who complete this program will be prepared to enter a two or four year program in any of the above fields and will also have had experiences similar to those of a working commercial artist.
