Career and Professional Studies

The program brings the world into the classroom as students, teachers, parents and the community work together to create a miniature society. Students apply learned concepts while managing or working in “real world” situations related to business, government, law enforcement, and non-profit agencies. Students think critically, solve problems as they arise, prepare and analyze budgets, and resolve ethical issues. This program follows a MicroSociety model, offering six thematic strands: technology, economy, careers, citizenship and government, humanities and arts, and volunteerism and ethics. These strands are infused into the existing Grade 6 and Grade 7 curricula, along with career exploration opportunities provided by local businesses and government agencies. In the final year, students have the opportunity to explore career options in Finance, Arts and Communication, Health and Human Services, and Science, Engineering and Information Technology.
