Fine Arts

Students may elect to pursue a pathway in Dance, Instrumental * or Vocal Music, Theatre Arts, or Visual Arts. In the performing arts pathways, students are prepared for individual and ensemble performances and are required to perform for a variety of audiences. Students participating in Theatre Arts may earn high school credit. In the Visual Arts pathway, students develop skills in the areas of drawing, painting, sculpture, printmaking, and ceramics. Students may earn high school credit by successfully passing the Visual Arts exam and a portfolio review. (**Instrumental Music does not include the study of string instruments or piano.*)
