On the Day of the Assessment

The assessment takes approximately 1 hour.

It is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s) to:

- ensure that the applicant attends the assessment on the scheduled date and time.
- contact the schools if scheduled magnet assessment appointments conflict.

Failure to attend an assessment WILL result in disqualification.

Registration Information

Applicants must attend the school-based assessment for the program to which they applied. All applicants will be contacted regarding a specific appointment time.

Applicants should arrive 15 minutes prior to their scheduled assessment time. Applicants should be accompanied by at least one parent/guardian. On average, the entire assessment takes approximately 1 hour. Parents are encouraged to stay during the assessments.

Magnet Assessment Date

On January 9 or 11, 2012, (inclement weather date: January 24 & 26, 2012), all applicants will be required to attend the magnet assessment at Sollers Point Technical High School. Applicants should be accompanied by at least one parent/guardian. On both days, applicants with last names starting with A-L will be assessed at 4:00 p.m. and applicants with last names starting with M-Z will be assessed at 5:30 p.m. Applicants should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled assessment time. Assessment reminders will be mailed to all applicants. **Parents/Guardians of applicants who have NOT received notification at least five (5) days prior to the assessment date must contact the school to verify/schedule an appointment.** Any applicant who has a scheduling conflict with another magnet school can receive an alternate time by contacting the schools directly.

Placement Prior to the Lottery

According to Superintendent's Rule 6400, *at the high school level where the number of qualified applicants exceeds the number of available seats, up to 20% of the seats may first be filled with candidates who show exceptional commitment and promise in the specialized program as evidenced by their performance on the approved magnet assessments. The remaining seats will be filled using the centralized random lottery selection process from the remaining pool of qualified applicants.* Specifically, applicants who earn the highest total combined scores on the on-site assessments may fill up to 20% of the seats available in the magnet program.

Qualifying for Admission

The applicant must earn at least 80 points from the stated criteria in order to qualify for admission.
