Parent Station Leader Responsibilities**

1. Set-up - 5 Stations

- Arrive early - 45 minutes before buses arrive
- Chaperones will come with bus.
- Bring materials listed below for your station.

Station #1 - Predator/Prey Game

Bring: Two colors of popcorn (plain white and yellow cheddar)

Station #2 - Homes and Hiding Places

Station #3 - Animal Blinds

Station #4 - Mammals and Birds of Maryland

Station #5 - Amphibians, Reptiles, and Fish

Bring: Instant Hand Sanitizer (Antibacterial)

2. Be Prepared To Teach Your Station

- Read script for background information and questions to ask students - use Socratic Method.
- You are not expected to know everything

3. Time Keeping

- Allow 30 minutes for each station. PLEASE WEAR A WATCH.
- Send your group in the correct direction to the next station - emphasize they are to follow the orange ribbons

4. Chaperones

- Ask chaperones to help you with activities at each station.
- Make sure students are chaperoned when using bathrooms.
- Help remind chaperones to straighten lunch area after use.

5. Communication

- Lead parent will communicate with teachers and station leaders.
- Call your school if you have questions about the weather (if school or Hereford Zone are late or closed, trip is cancelled).
