**Parent Station Leader Responsibilities**

**1. Set-up - 6 Stations**

- Arrive early - 45 minutes before busses arrive
- Chaperones will come with bus.
- Bring materials listed below for your first station.

**Station #1 - Modern Day Evaporator**

Bring: Split cost of maple sugar candy with Station #5 parent.

**Station #2 - Homestead Kettle**

Bring: Bundle of wood

**Station #3 - Native American Village**

Bring: Homemade Journey cakes

**Station #4 - Hogan**

Bring: Fire log (3-4 hour log only!!)

**Station #5 - "Sugar Bush" Hike**

Bring: Split cost of maple sugar candy with Station #1 parent.

**Station #6 - Auger and Spile**

Bring: "Wet Ones" for lunch.

**2. Be Prepared To Teach Each Station**

- Read script for background information and questions to ask students - use Socratic method.
- You are not expected to know everything

**3. Time Keeping**

- Allow about 15 minutes for each station. PLEASE WEAR A WATCH.

**4. Chaperones**

- Ask chaperones to help you with activities at each station.
- Make sure students are chaperoned when using bathrooms.
- Help remind chaperones to straighten lunch area after use.

**5. Communication**

- Lead parent will communicate with teachers and station leaders.
- Call your school if you have questions about the weather (if school or Hereford Zone are late or closed, trip is cancelled).
