APPLICATION STEPS

1. For your application to be considered, you must execute the following:

- Complete the attached *APPLICATION INFORMATION PAGE*.
- Compose an essay explaining why you want to serve as the student member of the Board of Education. (Essays should be no more than one page, double spaced.)

2. Submit a letter of recommendation from each of the following:*

- **Principal**
- **School Counselor**
- **English Teacher** (letter should provide information regarding communication skills)
- **Faculty advisor** of a *school organization* in which you are involved
- **Adult sponsor/leader** of a *community organization* in which you are involved.

***APPLICATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT ALL FIVE RECOMMENDATIONS**

3. Submit an official school transcript from the counseling office, including a copy of your most recent report card.

Selected Candidates will need to participate in the following activities:

1. Interviews- Wednesday, March 21, 2018 from 4:30–6:30 p.m. for qualifying candidates

2. Student Forum- April 6th at Pikesville High School (10:00 am -12:30 pm)

Selected candidates will participate in a student forum.

Each candidate will be allowed to give a 3 minute speech/presentation and participate in a question and answer session with students in attendance.

Following the forum, student leaders will nominate/recommend a student to the governor to serve as the next Student Member of the Board.

Candidates will receive written notification of the forums decision.
