



ADMINISTRATION: Administrative Operations

Conduct

- I. One of the primary goals of the Board of Education of Baltimore County (Board) is to provide a safe and orderly learning environment.

The Board directs the Superintendent to establish rules and procedures to address the conduct of all persons on school-owned or leased property, all school buses, Board-owned vehicles, and offsite school-sponsored activities, in accordance with all Board policies, Superintendent’s rules, and applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.
