



STUDENTS: NON-INSTRUCTIONAL Services

Accident Insurance

I. Availability

A. A student accident insurance program shall be made available to parents/guardians of students enrolled in Baltimore County Public Schools (BCPS). The parent/guardian shall pay the premium directly to the company and the contract shall be between the parent/guardian and the insurance company. The Board of Education of Baltimore County (Board) will not have any role or responsibility regarding insurance purchased by a parent/guardian.

II. Interscholastic Sport Requirements

A. Each student participating in interscholastic sports must have insurance coverage either through a parent's/guardian's current effective policy or through the purchase of the available student accident insurance.

B. For a student participating in interscholastic football, the parent/guardian purchasing the available student accident insurance must include the football coverage option.

C. Students shall not be denied an opportunity to try out for an interscholastic athletic team because of economic status.

III. Accident Reporting

All accidents, regardless of the type of insurance coverage, must be reported on the Baltimore County Public Schools Standard Student Accident Report form (BEBCO 49-615-98). Accidents shall be reported consistent with established procedures. If applicable, student accidents must be reported on the appropriate form provided by the student accident insurance company for this purpose.
