



PERSONNEL: Professional

Permanent: Assignment, Transfer, and Promotion

The teaching staff shall be assigned to particular school buildings by the Superintendent of Schools. Reassignment may be made when, in the judgment of the Superintendent, such reassignment or transfer is for the good of the school system. Teachers may apply for reassignment through the appropriate administrator, but the judgment of the Superintendent is final.

The Board of Education reserves the right to reassign the work of the teacher in fields of special training or capabilities at any time during the life of the contract through the Superintendent of Schools and the appropriate administrator.

A teacher who is teaching in more than one school will have designated as his/her home school the one to which he/she is assigned for the greatest amount of time. In the event the amount of time is equal between two or more schools, the home school assignment normally will be the one closest to the teacher's residence.

The Board of Education recognizes that the welfare of the children demands that the best candidates for promotions be chosen, wherever they may reside.
