



STUDENTS

The focus of the school system shall be on the student. His/her educational development toward the goals of the schools shall be the central concern of the policies of the Board of Education and the Superintendent's rules.

Each student shall be given equal opportunity. Since students vary widely in capacities, interests, and social and economic background, no two can be treated alike if the fullest development of each shall be achieved.

The Board of Education shall attempt to eradicate any limitations of facilities and means that stand in the way of the availability of our schools to all in Baltimore County who wish to learn. Children receiving home instruction shall not be enrolled in public school programs. They can request standardized testing and special education services.
