



STUDENTS: Enrollment and Attendance

Students shall be required to attend the schools of Baltimore County in accordance with state law.

Every child between five and sixteen years of age must be enrolled in schools according to placement determined by admission standards and or examination.

Older youths and adults are encouraged to take advantage of opportunities available through evening high school and adult education classes in order to qualify for a high school diploma, to improve their cultural or academic backgrounds, or to improve their vocational skills.

Parents shall be required to enroll all eligible children in kindergarten.
