



NEW CONSTRUCTION: Financing

Capital Projects that are Funded by Private Donations

I. Philosophy

- A. The Board of Education of Baltimore County (Board) recognizes that individuals, private organizations, parents, community groups, or businesses may wish to provide funding for capital projects.
- B. Funds may not be accepted if acceptance would create a conflict of interest or provide benefit to an individual, in violation of the Board's ethics code policies.
- C. Any requests for naming of the capital project must comply with all Board policies.

II. Implementation

- A. The Board hereby directs the Superintendent to establish the necessary procedures for accepting private donations for capital projects.
