



INTERNAL BOARD POLICIES: Operations

Meetings: Participation by the Public

- I. Citizens of the county have the expressed right and are encouraged to attend all public meetings of the Board of Education of Baltimore County (Board) and to observe the deliberation of its members.
- II. Any citizen who wishes to address the Board at one of its business meetings must complete the requisite sign-in form prior to the opening of each meeting, and provide the agenda item or educational topic he/she wishes to discuss.
- III. It is the practice of the Board to provide an opportunity for stakeholder groups to report the results of their meetings and group activities at each of its business meetings. For the purpose of this policy, stakeholder groups are identified as those existing as of the 2008-2009 school year.
