0004 Instructional Textbooks and Supplies - \$ 784,193

An increase of \$784,193 in Instructional Textooks and Supplies will be used for start-up costs for New Town High.

0010 - Operation of Plant - \$781,596

An increase of \$781,596 is necessary to cover the additional expenses for snow removal, overtime, and utilities due to the severe winter weather.

Summary of Decreases by Category

0003 - Instructional Salaries - \$1,565,789

\$1,565,789 is projected to be available in Instructional Salaries due to turnover savings greater than the amount orginally budgeted, fewer new hires, EYE savings and a reduction in workshops held.
