## Request for Approval Establish Construction Contingency Allocation for Driveway and Parking Lot Improvements at Hereford High School July 8, 2003

On December 3, 2002, the Board of Education approved a request to provide the Maryland State Highway Administration funding for enhancements to the Hereford High School driveway and parking lot. The funds approved at that time did not include provisions for a construction contingency allocation. The portion of this project funded by Baltimore County Public School was \$288,739.05. At this time, the Department of Physical Facilities requests approval to establish a 10% construction contingency allocation in the amount of \$28,873.00, to cover any unforeseen conditions and minor changes to the contract.
