## Recommendation for Increase Contingency Authorization Chairlift Installation at Elmwood Elementary School July 8, 2003

On April 22, 2003, the Board of Education approved an award of contract with RWC Contracting Corporation to install a vertical chairlift at Elmwood Elementary School. In order to complete this project, the State Inspector has requested that three fire-rated doors be installed on the shaft housing the chairlift. The original contingency established for this project was \$6,339.00. At this time, the Department of Physical Facilities requests approval to increase this contingency by \$4,205.00 in order to furnish and install three fire-rated doors. The final contingency for this project, provided this requested increase is approved, will equal \$10,544.00, or approximately 16.6% of the total contract award of \$63,390.00.

Funding for this increase contingency allocation is available through the Qualified Zone Academy Bond Program.
