NORTHWEST AREA EDUCATION ADVISORY COUNCIL OPERATING AND CAPITAL PRE-BUDGET HEARINGS OCTOBER 16, 2012

OPERATING BUDGET REQUESTS

Testimony received from <u>Randallstown HS</u> cited the need for approximately \$17.000 to purchase, install and maintain 50 to 60 computers and a staffing request for 3 para-educators to assist teachers with instruction and management of inclusion classrooms.

<u>Deer Park Middle Magnet School</u> is requesting \$20,000 to set up wireless internet access capability throughout the school that will include supporting the operation of two mobile computer labs and computerized testing. The school is also requesting \$3,000 to repair or replace cable wiring for its television broadcast studio and \$11,000 to purchase chairs and desks for school classrooms.

<u>Old Court MS</u> is requesting \$3,000-\$4,000 to purchase a LCD projector and projection screen for the school's cafetorium; \$1,000 to purchase a refrigerator for special education students; \$4,800+ to purchase an assortment of band instruments and band uniforms and funding for additional staff for the engineering and math components of the school's STEM program.

<u>Wellwood International ES</u> is requesting funds for additional staff including a French teacher for its magnet program; funding for purchasing science textbooks and general supplies for the school.

<u>Scotts Branch ES</u> needs funds to employ additional qualified para-educators to support and assist teachers with instruction of 1st grade students with developmental learning disabilities.

<u>Reisterstown ES</u> needs a fulltime Technology Integration teacher including funds for academic courses that will prepare students for enrollment in STEM programs offered at participating middle schools.

<u>Franklin HS</u> requests operating budget funding for memory upgrade of 70 computers at a unit cost of \$58.00 per computer (\$4,060).

<u>The Citizens Advisory Committee for Gifted and Talented Education</u> reiterated the need to provide professional development for faculty and school administrators in differentiation and responsive teaching related to the needs of high potential/high ability learners.

CAPITAL BUDGET REQUESTS

Randallstown HS requests \$17,000 to purchase a new scoreboard for the school's football and track field. It would replace the existing 30 year old scoreboard which has been inoperable for the last 10 years.

<u>Old Court MS</u> is requesting capital budget funds to build an auditorium in which to hold general assemblies, cultural programs and community activities.

<u>Pikesville HS</u> reiterates the need for BCPS to pursue scheduled comprehensive renovations that will improve the learning environment of the school building.

<u>Wellwood International ES</u> requests capital budget funding for the installation of a central air conditioning system to improve the learning environment of the school building.

<u>Scotts Branch ES's</u> testimony cited the need to repair/repave the sidewalks around the school, repair or replace playground equipment and install an air conditioning system in the school building.

<u>Reisterstown ES</u> requests a new inspection/assessment that will determine the type of air conditioning system that could improve the learning environment of the school building.

<u>Church Lane ES</u> submitted a capital budget request for installation of an air conditioning system in their school building.
