Small and minority-owned businesses are invited to participate in the 14th annual Meet the Primes event. This free event is hosted by Baltimore County Public Schools, Baltimore County government and agencies, and the Baltimore Metropolitan Council. This networking event is designed to connect small and minority-owned businesses with more than 120 prime bidders who offer subcontracting work opportunities, and with government and education agencies who offer bidding opportunities and resources to facilitate small business growth.
