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Northwest Area Elementary School Boundary Study committee to host public information meeting Nov. 8 to consider options, collect feedback

Meeting will be livestreamed on YouTube

What:

The committee charged with examining attendance areas and considering boundary options among seven northwestern-area elementary schools will host a public information session to provide information and gather public feedback about boundary option preferences and the study process. The meeting will include an explanation of the process, a presentation of data, and a question-and-answer period.

The study seeks to expand attendance areas for the replacement buildings for Bedford and Summit Park elementary schools, to provide capacity relief for other schools in the northwest, and to enable the move of students currently attending Campfield Early Learning Center to attend their home schools or nearby programs.

In addition to the public information session, the committee has had four meetings to examine the issue. Committee meetings, which take place from 6-8 p.m. on Wednesdays at Pikesville Middle School, continue Dec. 6, and, if needed, Dec. 13.
