ESY focuses on the maintenance of critical life skills as well as academic and functional goals/objectives identified on the IEP. Special education teachers and related service providers provide specialized instruction and services during ESY.</p>

Schools should be prioritizing support in both Literacy and Mathematics, based on the learning needs of students. ELD teachers should focus on teaching the academic language of the content area and differentiate their instruction, based on the language proficiency levels of their MLs.</p>
